## **2018 Level 4-10 State Championships**

- **ALL COACHES MUST BE REGISTERED THROUGH USA GYMNASTICS MEET RESERVATION TO BE ALLOWED ON THE FLOOR**
- All sessions will be modified capital cup (warm-up/compete) with continuous rotation
- Starting events for each squad as well as competition order within each squad will be drawn at random by the meet scoring program
- 2 sets equipment (AAI VT & UB, Mancino BB and FX). 12 cm mats
- Only coaches of competing athletes will be allowed on the floor.
- Athletes attending sessions in which they are not competing must remain in the spectator area.
- All warm-ups will be timed including vault and floor.
- Per R & P, competition order must be followed. Warm-ups for each flight may be conducted in any order as long as the first competitor warms up first.
- Gymnasts will march-in after general stretch. Timed warm-ups will follow march-in. Competition will begin immediately after timed warm-ups.
- It is the coach's responsibility to flash the correct number for the optional vault the gymnast performs for levels 8-10.
- Awards: 40% placement for Events and All Around. See the age groups on the next page. The age determination date is the last day of the culminating competition of the season, except level 9 & 10 which is the date of the state meet. All ties will be broken.
- Team Awards: 40% placement. Level 4 will have Small Team and Large Team divisions. The small team division will count the top 3 scores per event. The large team division will count the top 5 scores per event. Team Competition for Levels 5-9 will count 3 scores (there is no team competition for level 10). Small teams have 9 or fewer gymnasts registered. Large teams have 10 or more gymnasts registered.

- Athletic trainer will be on-site throughout the competition
- Hospitality will be available all day for coaches
- Seniors will be recognized along with their families and coaches. The JO Scholarship recipient will be announced at awards.

### **NH Regional Qualification:**

**Level 7: Top 7 AA athletes regardless of age division will qualify and represent NH as the Super Seven State Team. The next additional 8 AA athletes, regardless of age division will qualify as all stars.**

**Level 8: Top 7 AA athletes regardless of age division will qualify and represent NH as the Super Seven State Team. The next additional 9 AA athletes, regardless of age division will qualify as all stars.**

**Level 9 & 10: Regional Qualifying Score: All around: 34.00. Specialists: 9.0 per event.**

**Regional qualifiers will be announced at awards. All regional qualifiers MUST stay to be sized for regional apparel. To receive the regional apparel, the athlete must accept their qualification spot with the intention to compete. In the event that a level 7 or level 8 regional qualifier does not accept their spot, the next highest AA will fulfill their position.**

**All qualifiers (levels 7-10) are invited to attend a clinic at A2 Gym & Cheer on March 31 to help prepare for Regionals. The clinic will include judge's critiques from their state meet performance.**
